RE-ENTRY PLANNING

The Process

Presentation has established a committee of faculty and administrative staff that is developing a comprehensive re-entry strategy that prioritizes the health and wellness of our entire community. This strategy maintains the continuity of learning while continuing to deliver a meaningful Presentation experience. We are committed to working in partnership with our families, and recognize the need for a slow and intentional re-entry, allowing us to address and respond to the trauma many of our community has experienced--or will continue to experience as a result of the pandemic and quarantine.

Our Assumptions

We are continually monitoring all facets of this dynamic situation and recognize that this requires adaptive planning that will evolve as the science and circumstances do. Despite the uncertainty, we are developing plans based on the following assumptions informed by the most current guidance from public health officials:

School campuses will reopen in the 2020-2021 academic year with the probability that San Jose and the Bay Area will experience continued outbreaks of COVID-19 that may force us to revert to earlier phases of the shelter in place order. We must prepare for the potential of localized, rolling closures for approximately 14–28 days triggered by additional waves of infections.

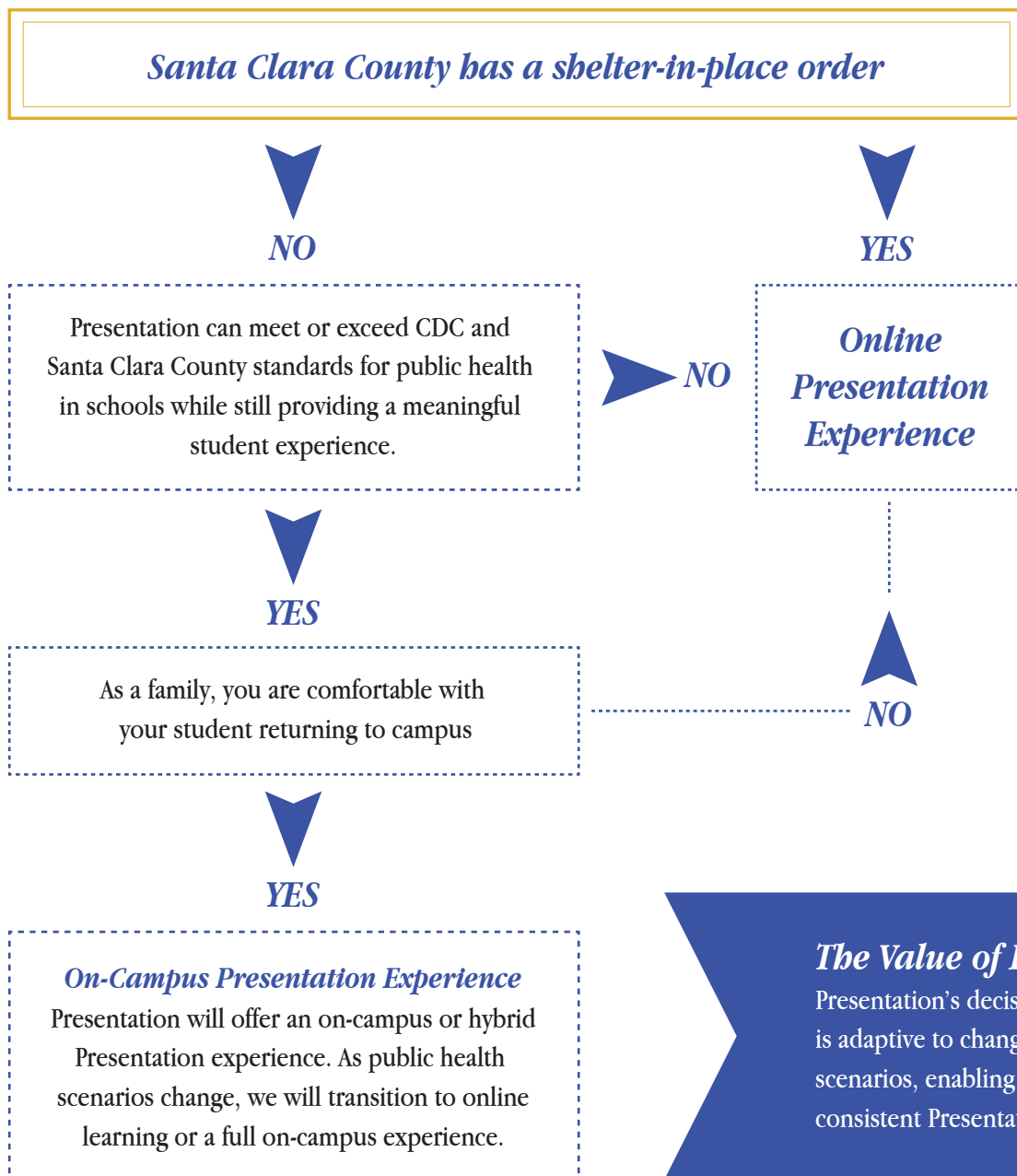
Our physical campus and social habits will require modifications based on guidance from national, state, and local health officials, which include physical distancing, wellness checks, masks, frequent disinfecting of classrooms, as well as intermittent transitions to online learning.

We will NOT be returning to a pre-COVID “normal” for some time and social distancing is here for the foreseeable future.

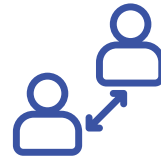
Additional health screening before and upon arrival to campus

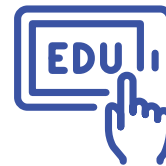
