

Presentation High School Prom Dance Information and Rules

Saturday, May 11th, is the Junior/Senior Prom. It promises to be a beautiful event and wonderful evening for all involved. We are planning an elegant dance to be held at the Club Auto Sport. The evening will begin with check-in and from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Guests must arrive by 7:30pm. From the school's point of view, we want two things: a memorable event and student safety. In order for both to be assured, there are a few regulations that we want you to know and discuss with your daughter. Each Presentation girl in attendance, will need to purchase a ticket for Prom.

Arrival time: All students and dates must arrive by 7:30 p.m. unless special written permission is given by Kristin Schneider. This permission is granted only if a note from a parent is given to Mrs. Schneider at least three days prior to the Prom stating the reasons for the late arrival and what time the student will arrive. We will call the parents of students not at the prom by 6:30 p.m. and latecomers will not be admitted.

Parking: Parking is available at the venue. Students can also take limos if they would like

Departure Time: Students must remain at Club Auto Sport until until 10:00 p.m. During the event, students may not leave the immediate area.

Dates: Dates must not be over the age of 20. All dates that are no longer in high school need to list college attending and include parent information on the Administrator Approval Form

Dress Code and Behavior: Behavior and dress appropriate to a formal dance will be expected of Presentation students and their dates. All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety. **Inappropriate dancing** includes, but is not limited to, the following: slam dancing, moshing, any dancing that has sexual innuendo such as freaking or booty dancing ("sandwich", crotch to crotch or butt to crotch). **(See full Diocesan Dance Policy in the Student Handbook). See Dress Code in the student handbook.** Also, shoes must be worn at all times.

Alcohol/ Drugs/ Smoking: Chaperones will be diligent in their efforts to judge whether either have been used or consumed. Any student who uses either alcohol or drugs will be liable for expulsion from school. We ask all parents to refrain from serving any alcoholic beverage to their daughters or their dates and to be firm in demanding that none are used at any time during the evening. Water bottles and other drink containers will not be permitted. Smoking/vaping is not allowed at any time during the dance. Bags and backpacks will not be allowed and handbags and jackets will be searched at the door.

Hotel: The school absolutely does not approve of students acquiring hotel rooms for the night of the prom. Parents, please do not rent a hotel room for your daughter. If any student participates in public behavior at any time that violates school rules, the school will impose appropriate disciplinary consequences including possible suspension or expulsion.

Valuables: All valuables should be left at home or in the trunk of the car. Presentation High School is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

As always, we sincerely thank each of you for your outstanding support of Presentation. Our regulations are to ensure that the evening is a fun filled and safe one from beginning to end.
